PRE-ORDER YOUR CHILD'S LUNCH

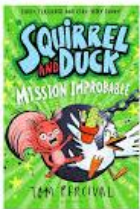
Please pre-order your child's meal!

One day last week **40** children had not ordered a meal and the cook had to defrost bread to make sandwiches. Our caterers have changed their delivery system and now the kitchen receives one order per week and cannot re-order mid-week if she has run out due to a higher demand than ordered.

You can order a meal up until 9am that day. If you are having problems ordering on line, call into the office and we will try to help you. If you have not ordered a meal for your child they will be given something to eat but it is not likely to be their first choice.

School meals are free of charge for children in reception, year one and year two. Parents who are not eligible for income related free school meals have to pay for meals taken by children in KS2. You pay online for your child's meals. You will receive a reminder email when you need to top up your account.
